When? Where? On December 13th, 14th, 17th, and January 17th, 18th, 21st, 22nd, the specified groups of students complete their assessments first thing in the morning (8:45 – 9:45), followed by a 55-minute break. Classes for the remainder of the day begin with period 3 at 10:40. Location of the assessment is dependent on the subject area and format of the assessment. Locations are posted in every homeroom. If your daughter does not have a scheduled assessment on one those dates, she does not have to be at school until 3rd period that day (@ 10:40).

Grade 8 and 11 ELA process Midyear: Students will be completing their process assessment between the dates of December 11 and 13. On the Tuesday and Wednesday they will be working on the process during their regularly scheduled class time. On Thursday, all grade 8 and 11 students are expected to be at school at 8:35 for the last part of their process assessment.

Grade 12 Provincial Standards Test: On Jan 8th, all Grade 12 students are expected to be at school by 8:45 for their 3-hour session which runs from 9:00 – 12:00. They have the afternoon off. From Jan 9th – 11th, students will complete the Provincial Standards test during their regularly scheduled ELA classes.

“Flex days” Alternatively scheduled assessments take place during the day for select subjects only.

- **December 13:**
 - Biology 40S - the three different sections will complete the assessment at designated times throughout the morning. Please confirm with your daughter what time she is expected to be at school.
 - Biology 30S - the three different sections will complete the assessment at designated times throughout the afternoon. Please confirm with your daughter what time she is expected to be at school.
- **January 17:**
 - Physics 40S students will be choosing appointment times in small groups at various times throughout the day. Please confirm with your daughter what time she has signed up for, and when she is expected to be at school
 - All grade 8 students will complete their project assessment at designated times throughout the day. Please confirm with your daughter what time she is expected to be at school.

While there are no scheduled classes, the school is open on both Flex days and teachers are available to students who may come in to work on research, group work, projects, and assignments. Our Library will be open. Supportive subject areas may choose this day to book assessments or provide time for project work.

“Balanced Time”: A balanced time period is in effect December 12 thru 17 and January 16 thru 22 (allows preceding evening to remain open for study time). Balanced time means no homework given, no other test or major assignment on those dates. The best interests of the students must be at the forefront of our practice at this time. Teaching, learning and classroom-based activities will proceed during class time, with respect for the demands on both students and teachers at this time.
