When? Where? On December 15th, 18th and January 19th, 22nd, 23rd, the specified groups of students complete their assessments first thing in the morning (8:45 – 9:45), followed by a break. Classes for the remainder of the day begin with period 3 at 10:40. Location of the assessment is dependent on the subject area and format of the assessment. Locations are posted in every homeroom. If your daughter does not have a scheduled assessment on one those dates, she does not have to be at school until 10:30 that day.

Grade 8 ELA process Midyear: Students will be completing their process assessment between the dates of December 11 and 14. On the Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, they will be working on the process during their regularly scheduled class time. On Thursday, all grade 8 students are expected to be at school by 8:35 for the last hour of their process assessment.

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Grade 12 Provincial Standards Test: All Grade 12 students are expected to be at school by 8:45 on Jan 9th for their 3 hour session which runs from 9:00 – 12:00. From Jan 10th – 12th, students will complete the Provincial Standards test during their regularly scheduled ELA classes.

“Flex days” While there are no scheduled classes, the school is open and alternatively scheduled assessments take place during the day for select subjects only. Teachers are available to students who may come in to work on research, group work, projects, and assignments. Our Library will be open. Supportive subject areas **may** choose this day to book assessments or provide time for project work.

- **December 14:**

- Biology 40S - the three different sections will complete the assessment at designated times throughout the morning. Please confirm with your daughter what time she is expected to be at school.
- Biology 30S - the three different sections will complete the assessment at designated times throughout the afternoon. Please confirm with your daughter what time she is expected to be at school.
- 10 Geo – all Grade 10 students are expected to be at school by 8:45 for their assessment

- **January 18:** Physics student in both grade levels will be choosing appointment times in small groups at various times throughout the day. Please confirm with your daughter what time she has signed up for, and when she is expected to be at school

“Balanced Time”: A balanced time period is in effect December 13 thru 18 and January 17 thru 23 (allows preceding evening to remain open for study time). Balanced time means no homework given, no other test or major assignment on those dates. The best interests of the students must be at the forefront of our practice at this time. Teaching and learning will proceed, with respect for the demands on both students and teachers at this time.
