New Student Orientation takes place on Wednesday, September 4 9:00 AM - All new students meet in Alumnae Hall. 9:15 AM - Students meet with their homeroom teachers until 10:00 a.m. 10:00 AM - School Orientation Tour 12:30 PM - Dismissal Uniforms are *not* required for Orientation morning. Classes begin for all students on **Thursday, September 5 at 8:30 AM.** This is Day 1 of the School Day cycle.

Homeroom lists will be posted in the cafeteria by 7:30 AM. Students are to proceed directly to their homeroom for 8:30 AM for opening exercises, locker distribution, timetable and agenda distribution.

Mandatory Assessments

Two major assessment periods take place during the school year, in January and June.

On January 17 and 20 major assessments for **some** subject areas take place. For **other** subjects, individual class assessments will take place during dates outside of the common assessment dates. This information will be conveyed to students and parents by the subject area teacher.

All students are expected to be present during the assessment periods, a doctor's certificate is required to verify illness or absence. Parents are asked to **NOT** book holidays or time away from school during these periods. If a student misses an assessment it will affect the value of their final mark.

These will be distributed during the first homeroom period on Thursday, September 5. Textbooks

On the first day of classes, subject teachers issue numbered textbooks to each student. Each assigned textbook is the responsibility of the student to whom it is assigned. In June 2019, students are responsible for returning assigned textbooks in accordance with the following procedures:

Non-exam courses: to the subject teacher at the last class.

Exam courses: prior to the final exam in a designated classroom.
