CHARISM CORNER...Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary in Canada began in 1843. However, they were officially established on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception – December 8th 1844. On that day the three novices, took their vows in the Chapel in the Longueuil convent. Sr. Marie -Rose was named the first Superior of the Congregation. It was very clear though, that these faith-filled women, recognized Mary as their actual first superior who watched over and guided the beginnings and growth of the congregation. Today, we continue to recognize the person of Mary at SMA, our SNJM school. So when you are enjoying December 8th, remember to say, "Thank you God, for the gift of Mary".
